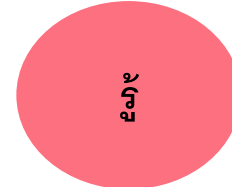

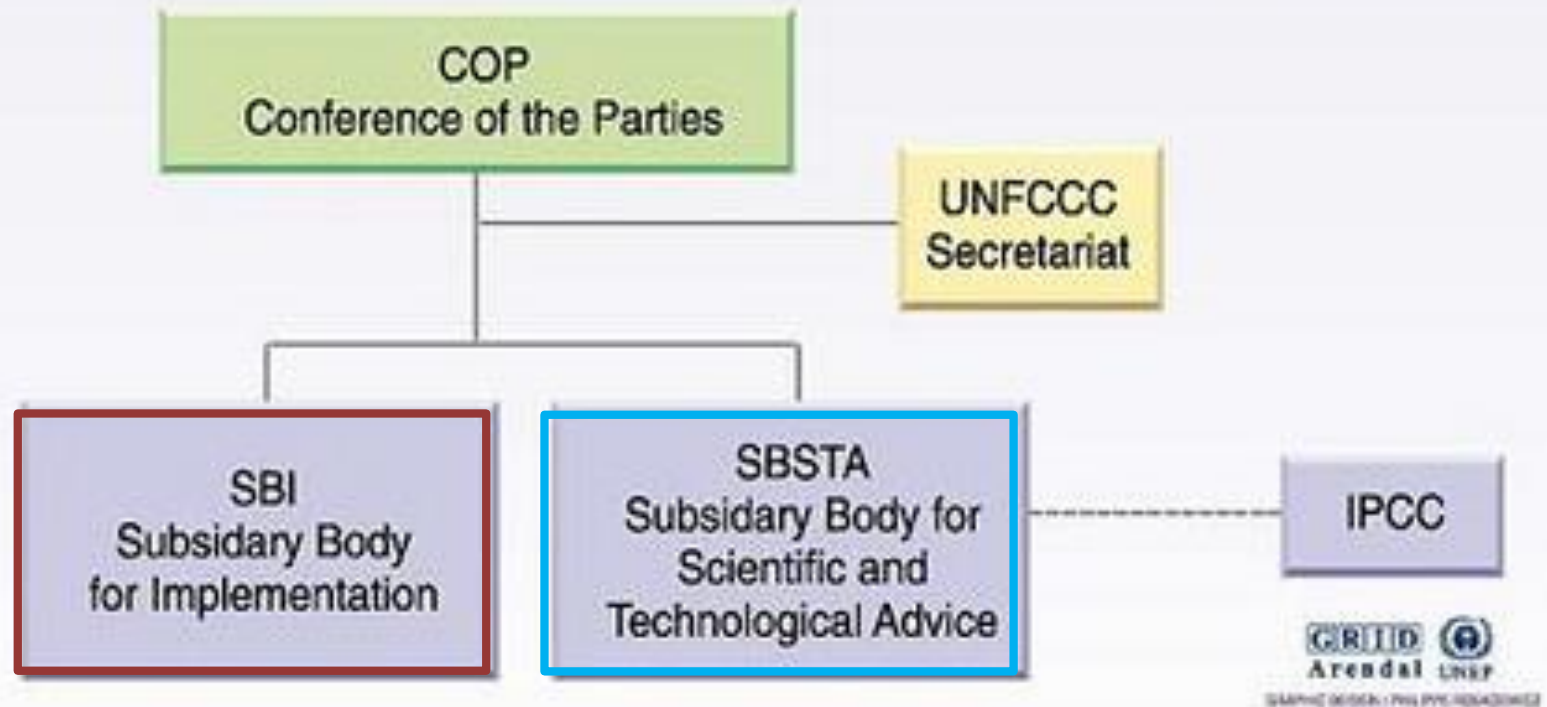

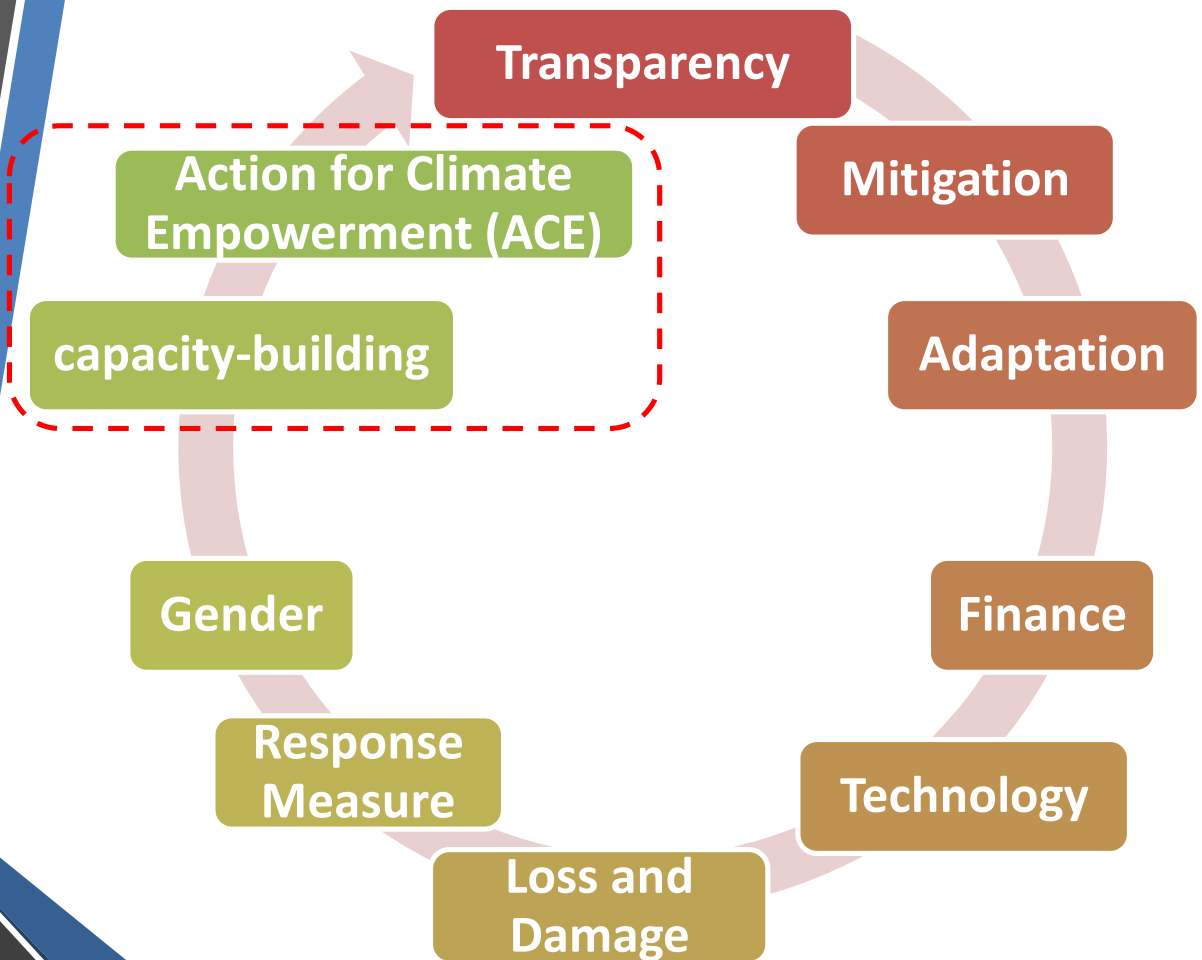

ACE Decision – Paris Agreement work programme

- **Alignment:** In 2020, when reviewing the Doha work programme on Article 6 of the Convention, to also include efforts related to the implementation of Article 12 of the Paris Agreement
- **Integration of ACE** into nationally determined contributions, national adaptation plans, long-term low greenhouse gas emission development strategies and climate policies
- **Development and implementation** of ACE national strategies in relation to Article 12 of the Paris Agreement
- **Nomination of ACE focal points** Parties that have not already done so to designate an ACE focal to provide necessary institutional support
- **Participation** of non-Party stakeholders to scale up the implementation of Action for Climate Empowerment




